This table estimates the correlation between NFIP participation/claims and demographic characteristics by regressing tract-by-year level NFIP policies in force (column 1) or log of dollar value of claims per policy (column 2) on annual tract-level characteristics from the ACS 5-year samples, available beginning in the 2005 to 2009 period. We take the midpoint of the 5-year ACS period as the year of the survey so the data period is 2007 through 2018. All specifications include year and county fixed effects.
