Disclosure Statement for Rohini Pande

(1) Every submitted article should state sources of financial support for the particular research it describes. If none, that fact should be stated.

National Science Foundation (grant SES-0752792), the US Department of Labor ILAB (DOL ILAB), the Centre for Microfinance (CMF) at IFMR, the Mossavar- Rahmani Center for Business and Government, the Real Estate Academic Initiative at Harvard University and the Exxon Mobil Foundation under the Closing the Global Gender Gap Initiative in Economic Participation (hosted by the Women and Public Policy Program at Harvard University)

(2) Each author of a submitted article should identify each interested party from whom she has received significant financial support, summing to at least \$10,000 in the past three years, in the form of consultant fees, retainers, grants and the like. The disclosure requirement also includes in-kind support, such as providing access to data. If the support in question comes with a non-disclosure obligation, that fact should be stated, along with as much information as the obligation permits. If there are no such sources of funds, that fact should be stated explicitly. An “interested” party is any individual, group, or organization that has a financial, ideological, or political stake related to the article.

Pande is a Board member for Jameel Poverty Action Lab who’s mission statement is the use of scientific evidence for poverty alleviation.

(3) Each author should disclose any paid or unpaid positions as officer, director, or board member of relevant non-profit organizations or profitmaking entities. A “relevant” organization is one whose policy positions, goals, or financial interests relate to the article.

Pande is a board member of Jameel Poverty Action Lab at MIT whose aim is to use scientific evidence to inform policy. She is also a board member of IFMR, India who hosts the Center for Microfinance and supports evidence-based policymaking.

(4) The disclosures required above apply to any close relative or partner of any author.
